**The registration fee is payable at the time of registration and is not included in the total fees.

Each parish pays a subsidy for the child/ren from their parish that attend St. Mary School. Please remember that in order to qualify for this parish subsidy, you must be a “Contributing Member” and are expected to meet **ALL THREE** criteria for your home parish **AND** St. Mary School. **If you do not meet the standard for all three criteria, your tuition will be revised to that of a Non-Catholic and Non-Contributing Member.**

A “Contributing Member” is defined as meeting **ALL** of the following:

- (1) A registered parishioner of St. Mary Parish (Avilla) or other Catholic sending parish in the surrounding area.
- (2) Supportive to home parish by participating physically (regular attendance at Sunday Mass) and financially by maintaining a consistent regular contribution.
- (3) Supportive to home parish and St. Mary School as a volunteer (especially BINGO and Scrip.)

Tuition assistance is available regardless of parish membership for those who qualify financially. Parents are asked to use the FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment in the spring of each year.
